COVID SHOW PRECAUTIONS

1. Animals must be pre entered either by post, online entry system, BACs or Paypal.
2. A map of the showground will be available to download.
3. Sanitizer will be available near to the secretary area, however PLEASE bring your own, preferably a size that will fit into your pocket.
4. Parking - Lorries must be the following distances apart: 5m (15ft) horses must be tied on the left side (passenger side) of your horsebox or trailer.
5. Please use your horsebox or trailer instead of the toilet facilities on the showground. If you need to use the public toilets, make sure there is only one person in at a time.
6. Please remember to keep at least 2 metres apart both in the ring and outside of the ring in addition to any queue you need to join.
7. If you feel unwell, please DO NOT attend.
8. The rings will be larger than usual with a limit on class numbers.
9. Pre entered animals may enter other classes on the day. Entries on the day will be taken verbally from a 2 metre distance. Only the competitor number and the class number will be required. Payment can be taken using the charity style money box at £10 per class (NO CHANGE WILL BE AVAILBLE) or via Paypal or BACs.
10. There will be NO entry forms OR timetables/schedules available, so please remember to bring your own copy of the schedule.

RULES:

1. The Show reserves the right to amalgamate any Class with less than 3 entries or sub-divide any class.
2. Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the class being judged, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.
3. The judge's decision is FINAL. Any abuse towards judges or officials will result in immediate disqualification.
4. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident or incident to animals, persons or property.
5. The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final.
6. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies in the correct class or classes.
7. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.
8. ENTRY FEES are NOT refundable after the close of postal entries – even with a Doctor / Veterinary Certificate. All requests for refund must be applied for in writing. Refunds will be due if the show is cancelled.
9. No trotting or cantering will be allowed in any public area, only in the designated warm up area.
10. All horses and ponies should have 3rd party and public liability insurance.
11. No Ponies may be plaited in pure bred M & M Classes.
12. Correctly secured British Standard skull caps/riding hats that meet the current BSI safety standards of PAS015: 1998/PAS015: 2011. VG1. ASTM F1163 04a. SNELL E2001. AS/NZ 3838 2003 onwards or latest standard must be worn at all times when mounted.
13. All children 14 years and under must wear HARD HATS when showing in-hand.
14. No loose dogs allowed on the showground/arenas.
15. Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".
16. Children must be three years old before competing in any ridden class.
17. All ponies entered in M & M classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and with entries on the day.
18. No Litter to be left anywhere and mucking out of horseboxes/trailers in the lorry park is strictly forbidden.
19. No behaviour of an offensive, abusive or unpleasant manner to any person at The East Anglia Horse Show will be tolerated. Any act of discourtesy to any Judge, Steward or any Show Official on the part of the competitor groom, rider, driver or agent of an animal, will, at the discretion of such Official disqualify that animal from being judged, in which case entry fees, prizes and charges will be forfeited. Exhibitors are reminded of their responsibility for the actions of others within their party.
20. No person shall ill-treat ANIMALS or CHILDREN at any time whether by misuse/excessive use of a whip, bit or any item of saddlery or in any other way whatsoever.
21. STALLIONS – in the interest of safety, stallions may only be ridden / driven / handled by persons over the age of 14 years – with the exception of Small Breeds Mountain & Moorland stallions, where the rider / handler must have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January in the current year. Stallions are not permitted in any Young Handler, Equitation, Junior Ridden M&M, Lead Rein or First Ridden classes. Drivers of stallions must have an active, responsible adult with them at all times
22. A fall of animal or rider whilst mounted in any class will result in disqualification and they MUST leave the ring DIS-MOUNTED. If an animal gets loose from it's handler whilst in the ring it will also result in disqualification.
23. No competitor shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant manner to any show official or judge at any show or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format, If a competitor is found to be doing so, they will not be allowed to enter any more TEAHS shows for the remainder of the season, if the competitor continues this behavior the ban will continue throughout the following season. TEAHS takes this behavior very seriously.

The Judges will not ride the exhibits in qualifiers but the judge will ride at the finals. There will be regional clinic days offering training from BSHA accredited trainers.

EQUIFEST

The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship class to be held at the East of England Showground on the 18th – 20th August 2022.

1. EQUIFEST OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND

Classes 3,5,6,7,8,9

Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

This class may be divided as appropriate.

2. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Classes 12,13

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.

This class may be divided as appropriate.

3. EQUIFEST OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN

Class 16

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

4. EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN

Class 17

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

6. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN SHOW PONIES

Class 14

Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

7. EQUIFEST OPEN SHOW PONY LEAD REIN

Class 16

Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

8. EQUIFEST OPEN SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN

Class 17

First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

9. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Class 14

Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

10. EQUIFEST OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONY- LEAD REIN

Class 16

Show Hunter Pony Lead Rein, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

15. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN HACKS

Class 32

Open Show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age.

16. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDING HORSES

Class 32

Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age.

17. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN COBS

Class 35

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders any age.

18. EQUIFEST OPEN MAXI COBS

Class 35

Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms – to be judged as Cobs. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders any age.

19. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN HUNTERS

Class 32

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

20. EQUIFEST OPEN SMALL HUNTERS

Class 32

Open Small Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

21. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN PART BREDS

Class 11

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Riders any age.

22. EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

Class 34

Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship subject to their show rules & conditions.

Classes may be divided according to entries.

23. EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

Class 24

Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships subject to their show rules & conditions

24. EQUIFEST OPEN IN HAND RIDING PONIES

Class 22

In hand Riding Ponies, stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age, not to exceed 153cms at maturity.

Classes may be divided according to entries.

25. JUNIOR RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND

Class 15

Mares and geldings, 4 years old & over, registered in the respective pure bred Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A,B,C & D. Riders of Small Breeds not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders of Large Breeds not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

ESUK

“This show is affiliated to Equine Sports UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championships taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 28th July – 31st July 2022. The three highest placed exhibits will qualify in each class”

ROYAL LONDON

“First, second and third placed horses/ponies not already qualified in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show to be held at The College Equestrian Centre, Keysoe, Beds MK44 2JP September 2022. If a horse/pony has already qualified, cards may be handed down to 6th place at judge’s discretion. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the International Showing Society within 21 days of the qualifying show.
