COVID SHOW PRECAUTIONS

1. Animals must be pre entered either by post, online entry system, BACs or Paypal.
2. A map of the showground will be available to download.
3. Sanitizer will be available near to the secretary area, however PLEASE bring your own, preferably a size that will fit into your pocket.
4. Please use your horsebox or trailer instead of the toilet facilities on the showground. If you need to use the public toilets, make sure there is only one person in at a time.
5. Please remember to keep at least 2 metres apart both in the ring and outside of the ring in addition to any queue you need to join.
6. If you feel unwell, please DO NOT attend.

To be eligible to win a WPCS Bronze Medal, ponies must be registered with the WPCS. A WPCS Bronze Medal will be presented to the Champion or the Reserve Champion, subject to Medal regulations, provided they are owned by a member of the WPCS or become a member within 14 days. (A copy of the WPCS medal rule is available from the WPCS). There are other requirements to be eligible to win a medal, ownerships being correct, stallions being licensed subject to WPCS Medal rules. (A copy of the WPCS medal rule is available from the WPCS)

Open to registered Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section C mares and geldings four years old and over, not exceeding 138 cm. Riders must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Open to registered Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section D, mares and geldings four years old and over, exceeding 138 cm but not exceeding 148cms (except for Welsh Section D and Dales). Riders must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

NPS/Supreme Products Young Rider Championship Qualifier – for rider up to 25 years

Two highest placed Welsh ponies are eligible for the WPCS Performance Medal Championship medals can be awarded to the highest placed Welsh ponies but no lower than fourth place.

This Class is a qualifier for The National Welsh Championship Show 2022 - National Ridden Welsh Breeds Championships sponsored by The Brynseion Stud. All 1st & 2nd placed registered Welsh exhibits (not already qualified) qualify to enter the respective National Welsh Ridden Championship class.

50. The NPS/RINGSIDE STUD M&M Open Ridden National Championship (MM-OR)

Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C, Welsh D

Open to registered pure bred M&M stallions, mares and geldings five years old or over.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship Qualifier– wear white arm bands.

NPS/Supreme Products Young Rider Championship Qualifier – for rider up to 25 years

NPS/Black Country Saddles M&M Championship Qualifier

Two highest placed Welsh ponies are eligible for the WPCS Performance Medal Championship medals can be awarded to the highest placed Welsh ponies but no lower than fourth place.

This Class is a qualifier for The National Welsh Championship Show 2022 - National Ridden Welsh Breeds Championships sponsored by The Brynseion Stud. All 1st & 2nd placed registered Welsh exhibits (not already qualified) qualify to enter the respective National Welsh Ridden Championship class.

*****NPS/STANDINGHAT STUD & SHOW TEAM M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship 1st & 2nd from Classes 49 - 55 ***** (SM-MMR)

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M Ridden section (excluding Leading Rein, First Ridden & WHP).

Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or the qualification.

51. Novice Lead Rein - Not to have won 3 firsts in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bridle, lead rein to be attached to the noseband.

52. Novice First Ridden - Not to have won 3 firsts in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bridle.

First and second prize winners from classes 46, 47, 56, 57 to compete.

Affiliation and Qualifiers

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern 2022.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/CORSCARON HORSE ESSENTIALS Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership number MUST be included on the entry form.

RULES:

1. The Show reserves the right to amalgamate any Class with less than 3 entries or sub-divide any class.
2. Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the class being judged, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.
3. The judge's decision is FINAL. Any abuse towards judges or officials will result in immediate disqualification.
4. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident or incident to animals, persons or property.
5. The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final.
6. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies in the correct class or classes.
7. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.
8. ENTRY FEES are NOT refundable after the close of postal entries – even with a Doctor / Veterinary Certificate. All requests for refund must be applied for in writing. Refunds will be due if the show is cancelled.
9. No trotting or cantering will be allowed in any public area, only in the designated warm up area.
10. All horses and ponies should have 3rd party and public liability insurance.
11. No Ponies may be plaited in pure bred M & M Classes.
12. Correctly secured British Standard skull caps/riding hats that meet the current BSI safety standards of PAS015: 1998/PAS015: 2011. VG1. ASTM F1163 04a. SNELL E2001. AS/NZ 3838 2003 onwards or latest standard must be worn at all times when mounted.
13. All children 14 years and under must wear HARD HATS when showing in-hand.
14. No loose dogs allowed on the showground/arenas.
15. Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".
16. Children must be three years old before competing in any ridden class.
17. All ponies entered in M & M classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and with entries on the day.
18. No Litter to be left anywhere and mucking out of horseboxes/trailers in the lorry park is strictly forbidden.
19. No behaviour of an offensive, abusive or unpleasant manner to any person at The East Anglia Horse Show will be tolerated. Any act of discourtesy to any Judge, Steward or any Show Official on the part of the competitor groom, rider, driver or agent of an animal, will, at the discretion of such Official disqualify that animal from being judged, in which case entry fees, prizes and charges will be forfeited. Exhibitors are reminded of their responsibility for the actions of others within their party.
20. No person shall ill-treat ANIMALS or CHILDREN at any time whether by misuse/excessive use of a whip, bit or any item of saddlery or in any other way whatsoever.

21. STALLIONS – in the interest of safety, stallions may only be ridden / driven / handled by persons over the age of 14 years – with the exception of Small Breeds Mountain & Moorland stallions, where the rider / handler must have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January in the current year. Stallions are not permitted in any Young Handler, Equitation, Junior Ridden M&M, Lead Rein or First Ridden classes. Drivers of stallions must have an active, responsible adult with them at all times

22. A fall of animal or rider whilst mounted in any class will result in disqualification and they MUST leave the ring DIS-MOUNTED. If an animal gets loose from it's handler whilst in the ring it will also result in disqualification.

23. No competitor shall behave in an offensive or abusive or unpleasant manner to any show official or judge at any show or via social media or the internet or via any publication in whatever format or via any other written or electronic format, If a competitor is found to be doing so, they will not be allowed to enter any more TEAHS shows for the remainder of the season, if the competitor continues this behavior the ban will continue throughout the following season. TEAHS takes this behavior very seriously.
